# Marina & Boatyard Rules & Regulations

Our goal is a safe, professional, welcoming marina and boatyard—especially for vessels staging for the Delaware Bay.

<b>Check-In &amp; Access</b>	All vessels and work crews must check in. Assignments at management discretion. Quiet hours: 10:00 PM-7:00 AM.
<b>General Safety</b>	No open flames while fueling. Fire extinguishers required. Children under 12 wear PFDs. No swimming. Keep walkways clear.
<b>Storm Hold Policy</b>	During unsafe Delaware Bay conditions, vessels may remain docked under Storm Hold as announced by staff/Captain's Call.
<b>Power, Water &amp; Fuel</b>	Marine-rated cords only. Report hot cords/burning smells. Follow fueling procedures. No fuel storage on docks.
<b>Ladder Safety</b>	Use stable, rated ladders; when in use, secure ladders to the boat topsides; maintain three points of contact; no damaged ladders; no ladder use in high winds.
<b>Electrical Safety</b>	Connections must be dry and fully seated. No household cords. Do not overload circuits. Report any shock/tingle immediately.
<b>Boats on the Hard - Shore Power</b>	Vessels on the hard shall NOT remain plugged into shore power during hull work, electrical work, washing, or hot work. Exceptions require staff approval and verified de-energization for the work area.
<b>Hot Work</b>	Welding/cutting/grinding requires marina approval and a fire watch. Power must be disconnected at the pedestal unless specifically authorized.
<b>Liveaboard Policy</b>	No liveaboards. Overnight stays limited to 12 days in any rolling 30-day period unless approved in writing by management.
<b>Environmental</b>	No discharge of sewage, oil, paint, or waste. Contain debris. Report spills immediately.
<b>Yard Work</b>	Work in assigned areas only. No sanding/grinding/painting without approval and containment.
<b>Travel Lift &amp; Equipment</b>	Only marina staff operate equipment. Stay clear of lift paths. Never stand under suspended loads.
<b>Vehicles &amp; Parking</b>	Designated parking only. 5 mph speed limit. Return marina carts promptly.
<b>Posted Safety Signs</b>	All guests and contractors must comply with posted supplemental safety signs and instructions throughout the marina and boatyard.
<b>Liability &amp; Insurance</b>	Owners responsible for mooring. Marina not liable for acts of God. Proof of insurance may be required.
<b>Compliance</b>	Violations may result in loss of privileges or removal. Policies subject to change.
